Membership Fee Implementation

After three years of construction, the Warrior Recreation Center at the Campus Center will finally open during the Spring Semester 2014. The Campus Center Board is implementing a membership fee for UH Manoa faculty, staff, and affiliated individuals/organizations to maintain the level of service that will be provided at the new Recreation Center and all the other programs and services operated by Student Recreation Services. Currently, students are paying a "Campus Center Renovation and Recreation Fee" which subsidizes operations and maintenance costs of the University Fitness Center at Stan Sheriff Center and other recreational facilities and programs. The Campus Center Board felt since there are other users besides students, it is only fair that everyone who utilizes the facility and service share in the cost to maintain and operate the facility. In addition, the additional funds will contribute to amortizing the building debt.

Students who carry a validated University of Hawaii at Manoa ID already pay the Rec Fee and will have full access to the facility and services. Memberships will be available for purchase for the following categories on campus including but not limited to faculty, staff, East-West Center faculty, the Research Cooperation of the University of Hawaii and the University Foundation staff (see attached fee categories). The Membership Fee will be available for purchase at the Campus Center Ticket, Information and ID Office. Once the opening date for the new Recreation Center is set, all current users will be allowed to use the facility for two weeks on a trial basis to decide if buying a membership is something they will want to do.

The 60,000 square foot addition to the Campus Center will include a large fitness center with cardiovascular machines, weight machines and free weights. In addition, the Warrior Recreation Center will include a gym for basketball, volleyball and badminton, a spinning room, an indoor running track and lockers and showers. The proposed hours of operation for the Rec Center will be 5:30 a.m. until 11:00 pm Monday through Friday and 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays.

Information sessions concerning the implementation of the membership fee will be held Wednesday, February 12, 2014 at 12:30 pm at the Kuykendall Auditorium; Thursday, February 13, 2014 at 2:30 pm at the Kuykendall Auditorium; and Tuesday, February 18, 2014 at 7:00 pm at the Physical Education/ Athletic Complex Lecture Hall (PE/A 241).
