

EWC Housing Weekly Update March 24

New Summer Travel and Housing Policies: The new policies are for the period from May 16, 2021, through August 1, 2021. The full policy document is attached and will be available on the Student Portal [EWC COVID-19 Policy and Resource Site](#).

Travel: This policy applies to all students regardless of vaccine status and covers all travel off the island of O'ahu. The policy notes the CDC recommendation that you not travel at this time, particularly in light of the spread of COVID-19 variants. Policy highlights:

- Non-essential travel by EWC students may be subject to additional Lincoln Hall Room charges.
- If you decide to travel, note that Housing will not be accepting returns before July 3, 2021.
- If residents must travel, they will need to spend two weeks in Lincoln Hall in either *self-isolation* or *quarantine* before returning to EWC dorms.
- Residents must notify Housing and their Program Coordinator in advance of travel and make a Lincoln Hall reservation with Housing for the 14-day period after return.
- **The travel policy could change** if there is a significant change in the COVID-19 situation in Hawai'i or locations where students are traveling.

Housing Policy for residents whose awards will be ending

- A maximum 30-Day extension may be requested beyond Award end date.
- No additional extension requests will be accepted.
- Extraordinary requests should be directed from residents to their EP Program Coordinator, who will communicate such requests to Housing.
