

# East-West Center Housing Travel Policy

**Effective Date: April 15, 2022**

Effective April 15, the EWC will no longer require residents traveling out-of-state to self-isolate at Lincoln Hall before returning to their dorm room at HM/HK. If a resident is exempt from the State of Hawai'i's quarantine requirement, they may return directly to their dorm room.\*

However, travel continues to be a risk and we ask all residents to take extra precautions upon returning from travel to mitigate risk to our community members. **Returning travelers are requested to wear a high-quality mask for a minimum of 3 days, closely monitor symptoms, maintain social distancing, and request a test kit from the front desk if you believe you have been in an area of increased risk.**

**\*Note:** if a resident is not exempt from the State of Hawai'i's quarantine requirement, they must still quarantine at Lincoln Hall per State of Hawai'i regulations and EWC Housing Quarantine Guidelines.

## **This travel policy could change**

This policy will be in place starting April 15, 2022, unless there is a significant change in the COVID-19 situation in Hawai'i (either for better or for worse).

Please be advised that new rules and restrictions on travel could be imposed at any time, both in the State of Hawai'i or in locations where students are traveling. This policy does not guarantee against the possibility of having to undergo a strict quarantine upon return should state or city/country policies change.
